Whether you are looking for a venue to host a wedding, corporate celebration, business presentation, holiday party, quinceañera, or workshop, the City of Yuma has many venues to choose from:

- ◆ The **Yuma Art Center and Historic Yuma Theatre** located at 254 S. Main Street - 928-373-5202
- ◆ The **Yuma Civic Center and Desert Sun Stadium** located at 1440 W. Desert Hills Drive - 928-373-5040
- ◆ The **Yuma Readiness and Community Center** located at 6550 East 24th Street - 928-373-5239
- ◆ The **North End Community Center** located at 160 E. First Street - 928-373-5245

Each venue has policies unique to their site. General rental information is provided here. For complete policies and information please contact the facility of interest.

### Definitions

- ◆ Residents are those people living within Yuma city limits
- ◆ Non-Profits are individuals, groups, or organizations using facilities whose purpose is clearly of a non-profit nature. This applies to organizations that have been given exempt status Section 501 of the United States IRS code
- ◆ Non-Residents are those people living outside the Yuma city limits
- ◆ Commercial is the term used for individuals, groups, or organizations whose purpose is of a profit making nature



The Yuma Readiness and Community Center is a joint use facility between the City of Yuma and the Arizona Army National Guard. It is a multi-purpose facility featuring a gymnasium and classroom space.

### Gymnasium - Special Event Rentals

(includes tables and chairs)

\$122 per hour - Residents / Non-Profit

\$243 per hour - Non-residents / Commercial

Four hour minimum and \$25 for each additional hour

### Gymnasium - Games and Practices

\$35 per hour - Residents / Non-Profit

\$69 per hour - Non-residents / Commercial

Three hour minimum and \$10 for each additional hour

### Classroom B

\$24 per hour - Residents / Non-Profit

\$46 per hour - Non-residents / Commercial

Three hour minimum and \$10 for each additional hour

### Other Rental Fees

\$16 per hour - Site Supervisor for after hours rentals

\$28 min. / \$60 max. clean up fee

Three hour minimum and \$10 for each additional hour

### Rental Guidelines

- ◆ Kitchen facilities are not available for rental. However, a licensed catering service, restaurant, or party planner may be used
- ◆ If alcoholic beverages are to be sold to the public at your event, a Special Event Liquor License must be obtained from the City Clerk's office a minimum of 60 days prior to the event
- ◆ Licensed security may be required
- ◆ Liability insurance is required and must list the City of Yuma as an additional insured

## YUMA ART CENTER AND HISTORIC YUMA THEATRE



The Yuma Art Center and Historic Yuma Theatre offer a unique and creative environment with several multi-use spaces available for rent.

- ◆ 640 seat Historic Yuma Theatre with ADA accessible spaces, (129 balcony seats, 135 front floor seats, and 376 main floor seats) with dressing / support space in the nearby United Building
- ◆ 4,320 square foot gallery space
- ◆ 1,449 square foot courtyard
- ◆ Classrooms and meeting space

### Historic Yuma Theatre

September– May  
\$300 - Non-Profit / \$600 Commercial  
June-August  
\$150 - Non-Profit / \$250 Commercial

☞ Rental rates are for a four hour period. Each additional hour is charged at 25% of the rental rate. A 10% discount is given for set-up / tear-down time and rehearsals.

### The Yuma Art Center Galleries

\$400 - Non-Profit  
\$525 - Commercial

☞ A 25% non-refundable deposit is required to reserve any rental space and user must provide insurance naming the City of Yuma as additionally insured.

## NORTH END COMMUNITY CENTER



The North End Community Center (NECC) is conveniently located in historic downtown Yuma.

- ◆ There are two, separate, multi-purpose rooms that respectively seat 385/199 theater style or 180/93 banquet style. Additionally, there are two meeting rooms available to rent.

### Multi-Purpose Rooms

\$53 - per hour resident / non-profit  
\$78 - per hour non-resident / commercial

### Small Conference Rooms

\$24- per hour resident / non-profit  
\$46 - per hour non-resident / commercial

☞ Rental rates are quoted based on an hourly rate with a three hour minimum and \$25 for each additional hour.

## YUMA CIVIC CENTER & DESERT SUN STADIUM



With 43,000 square feet of space, the Yuma Civic Center is the largest event venue in Yuma and offers flexibility for a wide variety of occasions.

- ◆ Customers may select Yuma Civic Center catering which provides a one stop option with experienced, creative staff and unique menu options
  - ◆ Private party customers may select to have their family provide food. If this option is selected the customer must carry product liability insurance at a minimum of \$1,000,000

### Desert Sun Stadium (An Outdoor Facility)

\$28 - per hour youth baseball tournaments or special games (opener/championship)\*  
\$77 - per hour non-profit (four hour minimum)  
\$105 - per hour commercial (four hour minimum)  
\$61 - per hour lighting

Desert Sun Stadium has a seating capacity of 6,590 with 32 linear feet of concession serving counter, men's and women's restrooms, ticket booths, storage, press box, and radio booth.

\*Stadium was created as an economic development tool to attract professional baseball organizations to Yuma. This remains a top priority for this facility.
