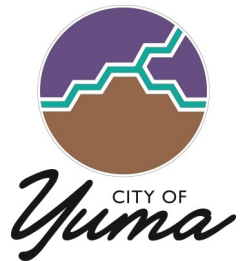

Whether you are looking for a venue to host a sporting event, family picnic, quinceañera, corporate celebration, or birthday pool party, the City of Yuma has a vast selection of venues to choose from. This brochure contains reservation information. Please call us at 928-373-5200 with questions or to reserve a site for your event.

Making a Request

- All requests must be received a minimum of 10 days prior to the date of your event
- Facilities may be reserved no more than 12 months in advance
- Each facility reservation request is reviewed and approved by a review committee
- A certificate of insurance may be required for events
- For multi-day events with attendance expected to exceed 1,000 people or more, please contact Yuma Parks and Recreation.
- Insurance is required for events that advertise to the public

Definitions

- Residents are those people living within Yuma city limits.
- Non-Profits are individuals, groups, or organizations using facilities whose purpose is clearly of a non-profit nature. This applies to organizations that have been given exempt status Section 501 of the United States IRS code.
- Non-Residents are those people living outside the Yuma city limits.
- Commercial is the term used for individuals, groups, or organizations whose purpose is clearly of a profit making nature.
- A special event liquor license is required if the sale of alcohol is planned.
